The School of Biblical Hebrew is located in two newly renovated buildings (residential & learning center). The residential building, located on Ethiopia Street, is three floors and contains 18 bedrooms with a bathroom in each; two small kitchenettes, a small laundry area and a reception/utility room are shared. There is also a large balcony that can be used for dining. It is situated on the edge of the historic Ethiopian Orthodox Church of Jerusalem compound.

A short walk of about five minutes from the residential building is the learning facility. The compound contains a classroom, library, dining room, kitchen, and office around a garden courtyard. This building was part of a larger campus used by Kol Israel (Voice of Israel), a government radio company, for approximately 85 years.

Accreditation, Visas & Library Facilities

Students who successfully complete the program will receive a graduate certificate in Biblical Hebrew. Qualifying students may also continue to obtain an MA in Classical Hebrew by completing several additional courses offered either on site or online through our partner universities.

The IBLT/SBH is an affiliated program of the University of the Holy Land and of Corban University, universities accredited by the Asia Theological Association and the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (USA Dept. of Ed.) respectively.

SBH Students will have access to the Hebrew University research and library facilities.
